Title of paper:	TO ADOPT THE IHRA DEFINITION OF ANTI-SEMITISM

FOR ACTION:

Guild Council welcomes the decision of the University of Exeter, and of the OfS, to adopt the IHRA definition of antisemitism, as supported by the Board of Deputies of British Jews, and resolves that the Guild shall also adopt the IHRA definition of anti-Semitism.

- S.C. HB: Propose we adopt, in-line with University.
- S.O. To counter institutional blocks and implied bias.
- VP Activities: Waiting to hear what definition the University has adopted and any changes they have made. Waiting to hear what the University have done.
- For information: University have not confirmed the wording they have adopted, and have not publicised any decision.
- VP Activities: to take to University staff who would know.
- S.C. HB: Believe it is the right definition to adopt; do not need to wait for the University to tell Council what decision it should make.

VOTE - YES: UNANIMOUSLY
